Nova Scotia & the Canadian Maritimes Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Halifax, Nova Scotia

Today board your flight bound for Canada's Atlantic Coast. Upon arrival in **Halifax** meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for a two night stay.

Overnight: Halifax, NS

Day 2: Halifax Sightseeing

Today enjoy a **Halifax City Tour** featuring **Bedford Basin**, the **Public Gardens**, **St. Mary's University**, **Point Pleasant Park** and the **Citadel**, a large star-shaped masonry fort built to protect the city. This afternoon visit a Nova Scotia highlight, **Peggy's Cove** famous for its rock shore and lighthouse. Tonight meet your fellow travelers for a **Welcome Dinner** hosted by your Tour Director.

Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Halifax, NS

Day 3: Halifax - Baddeck

This morning travel to **Cape Breton Island**. Enjoy a scenic drive around **Bras D'or Lake** to the lakeside resort town of **Baddeck**. This afternoon visit the **Alexander Graham Bell National Museum** to view many of Bell's artifacts, inventions and personal mementos. Later check into your hotel for a two-night stay.

Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Baddeck

Day 4: Cabot Trail

Enjoy a journey along the famous **Cabot Trail** explored by Englishman John Cabot in the late 15th century. The Cabot Trail is one of the most spectacular highways in North America. Along the way stop in the seafaring town of **Margaree Harbor** and visit the scenic city of **Cheticamp**, known for its hook rugs. Then follow the trail to **Cape Breton Highlands National Park**, where deep-walled canyons, sandy beaches and majestic cliffs are found. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Baddeck

Day 5: Travel to Charlottetown, PEI

Depart Cape Breton crossing the Canso Strait. Later board a ferry and travel to **Prince Edward Island (PEI)**. Enroute cross the Northumberland Strait, which separates Nova Scotia and New Brunswick from Prince Edward Island. This area features some of the warmest waters of the North Atlantic. Arrive in **Charlottetown** for a two-night stay. Tonight enjoy a **Lobster Dinner** with your fellow travelers.

Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Charlottetown, PEI

Day 6: Prince Edward Island Sightseeing

Today enjoy a **Prince Edward Island Tour**. Visit the **College of Piping** to learn about traditional Celtic music. Later travel through **Prince Edward Island National Park** with its varied landscapes and wildlife along the Gulf of St. Lawrence. Visit **Cavendish** to tour the **Green Gables Farmhouse & Museum**, the setting of Lucy Maud Montgomery's popular novel, *Anne of Green Gables*.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Charlottetown, PEI

Day 7: Charlottetown, PEI - Western Shore, NS

Today's scenic drive begins as you depart Prince Edward Island and cross the **Confederation Bridge** into **New Brunswick**. The scenery unfolds as you make your way through New Brunswick and Nova Scotia. This afternoon arrive at the **Oak Island Resort** situated on Nova Scotia's Western Shore nearby Mahone Bay. Enjoy another two-night stay.

Meal: (B) Overnight: Western Shore, NS

Day 8: Grand Pre - Bay of Fundy - Lunenburg

Start your day with a visit to the **Grand Pre National Historical Site** to learn about Acadian history and culture. Acadian exiles were the forefathers of Louisiana's Cajun people. Then visit **Halls Harbor**, an authentic fishing village famous for 45 foot tides due to its location on the **Bay of Fundy**. Later visit the scenic seafaring town of **Lunenburg** featuring a colorful waterfront, narrow streets and captivating architecture. The Old Town was bestowed the honor as a UNESCO world heritage site in 1995. Tonight join your Tour Director and fellow travelers for a **Farewell Dinner**.

Day 9: Transfer to Halifax Airport - Flight Home

Today transfer to the airport in Halifax for your flight home filled with wonderful memories of your **Nova Scotia & the Canadian Maritimes Tour**.

CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN

Payment of the per person Cancellation Waiver (waiver fee) guarantees full refund on all payments (including deposit), except the waiver fee itself, made for tour rates in case of cancellation up to the time & date of departure due to the passenger's personal illness (medical documentation required) or death of a member of the immediate family (official documentation required). Payment of the waiver fee guarantees your return air transportation utilizing your original airlines tickets with no additional supplement. The waiver does not cover return transportation costs other than return air transportation utilizing original airline tickets. The waiver fee is fully refundable until 180 days prior to departure. **The waiver fee does not cover any single supplement charges which arise from an individual's traveling companion electing to cancel for any reason prior to departure.** The waiver is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. The waiver does not cover any services such as airline tickets not purchased through Premier World Discovery. Post Departure coverage (Accident/Medical) is included. CANCELLATION FEES

Cancellations not covered by the waiver or if the waiver is not purchased, are subject to the following per person fees:

- Cancel more than 180 days prior to departure: Full Refund
- Cancel 179-75 days prior to departure: Deposit or Waiver is Retained
- Cancel 74-45 days prior to departure: 25% of total price
- Cancel 44-15 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds

IMPORTANT CONDITIONS/NOTES

- A valid US passport is required for this tour and is the responsibility of each passenger. Passports should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the travel dates. All names must be submitted to Premier exactly as they appear on passenger passports.
