Southern California & Queen Mary Getaway Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to L.A. - Long Beach - Queen Mary

Welcome to beautiful Southern California. Transfer to the legendary **Queen Mary**, your home for the next **five nights** and once the grandest ocean liner in the world. The Queen Mary is now a full-service floating hotel, historical landmark, and entertainment venue offering a unique glimpse into a bygone era when steamships were the most regal way to travel. This evening enjoy a **Welcome Dinner**.

Meal: (D) Overnight - Queen Mary

Day 2: Long Beach - Palos Verdes Peninsula - USS Iowa

This morning enjoy a **Queen Mary Walking Tour** to learn about her glamorous history, art deco beauty and her historical significance as the "Grey Ghost" during WWII. Next travel along the Pacific Ocean to the **Wayfarers Chapel**, also known as the "glass church", built by architect Lloyd Wright and listed on the National Registry of Historic Places, the chapel is located high above the Pacific Ocean among redwood trees. Visit the **Point Vicente Interpretive Center** to learn about the Pacific Gray Whale and one of the few spots along the California Coastline where migrating Gray Whale and other marine mammals can be spotted on any given day from November through April. Enjoy an included lunch at a scenic local restaurant early this afternoon. Later visit the **USS Iowa**, now a maritime museum located at the Port of Los Angeles. The USS Iowa (BB-61), was the lead ship of the Iowa class battleship and originally commissioned for World War II in 1943. *The Big Stick* housed 2,800 sailors and hosted 3 US Presidents, and also played a part in the Korean and Cold Wars.

Day 3: L.A. City Tour - Getty Center

Today embark on a panoramic **Los Angeles City Tour** featuring Downtown Los Angeles, **Staples Center**, **Disney Hall**, **Beverly Hills**, **Rodeo Drive**, **Hollywood**, **Grauman's Chinese Theater** and the **Hollywood Walk of Fame**. Then have time for lunch on your own & maybe a little shopping at **The Grove** and the historic **LA Farmer's Market**. Next visit the beautiful **Getty Center Museum** which is privately funded by the John Paul Getty Trust. The Getty Center houses European paintings, drawings, sculptures, illuminated manuscripts, decorative arts and European & American photographs all from a spectacular hilltop location overlooking Los Angeles. Return to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

Meal: (B) Overnight - Queen Mary

Day 4: Day at Leisure or Catalina Island Optional Tour

Today is at leisure to explore on your own or enjoy the full day optional tour to Catalina Island. Board your ferry for a cruise to Catalina and arrive in the beautiful city of Avalon, a Mediterranean-like town just 26 miles off the California Coast. Board a Tram for an Avalon City Tour to learn some of the Island's great history. Hear about the Wrigley Family and stories about the days when the Chicago Cubs held spring training on the island.

Visit and enjoy a walking tour of the iconic Catalina Casino showcasing the glamorous history of the Golden Age of Hollywood and Big Bands. The Casino is a testament to art deco architecture featuring the Casino Ballroom where singers like Frank Sinatra and Bing Crosby romanced the crowd and Big Band music such as Benny Goodman and Glen Miller made them swing. Also enjoy time to visit Avalon at your own pace to shop, dine, relax and explore the quaint town. Later return via ferry with the evening at your leisure.

Day 5: Rose Bowl Stadium - Old Town Pasadena - Warner Brothers Studio

This morning travel to Pasadena to enjoy a **Rose Bowl Stadium Tour**. The famous stadium only recently opened its gates to the public for guided tours and a chance to walk through the National Historic Landmark where countless moments in sports history have been made. Your guide will lead you through behind the scenes locations at the stadium including the classic stadium seating, original 1922 locker room, the new Terry Donahue Pavilion, the Loge Lounge, the Working Press Box and more. Then stop in historic **Old Town Pasadena** filled with quaint shops, cafes and restaurants for some time at leisure. This afternoon it's off for a "behind-the-scenes tour" of your favorite shows and movies at **Warner Brothers Studio**, the world's busiest motion picture and television studio. Your Warner Brothers guided tour offers a rare and intimate glimpse into real Hollywood at work and takes you through back lot streets, sound stages, sets and craft shops. See up close how sets are constructed as well as your favorite vehicles from film and television. This evening join your fellow travelers for a **Farewell Dinner**.

- Cancel 44-15 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds
